The interior floors will be plywood. Laminated glass will be used for the main windows for its high strength along with wooden joinery for weather tight capacity.



The functionality of our structure focuses on communication and observation by having two separate heights it helps the lifeguards, giving them a wider view when searching for any signs of danger. Having a short distance between the two towers to ensure quick communication..
